## **BEST PRACTICES HOSPITALITY/SERVANTHOOD**

## Navigators Quote 'You know if you have servants heart, by the way you feel when you are treated like one'

Biblical Principle "Your attitude should be the same as that of Jesus Christ, who... made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant... He humbled Himself and became obedient to death" (Philippians 2:5, 7, 8)

## Some guiding principles:

- a) Do what you say you will do!
- b) Be good new before you speak good news. Love them until they ask you why?
- c) Be sensitive about wearing CS branded clothing, does it serve or hinder?
- d) Be aware of whose event it is -do we have the right to do what ever we want?
- e) We need to gain respect, no one owes us anything
- f) Don't expect thanks, but its great if it comes.
- g) Be aware others will be watching from a distance!!
- h) Surround everything in prayer (before, during and after)
- i) Stay till the event has completely ended, not with the spectators
- i) Beware of throwing valuable resource at surfers that do not really need it
- k) Prove your sincere motives, don't veil your outreach behind 'give-aways'

## Ideas on using servanthood as a way of Surf 'Outreach'

- 1. Supplying Teas and Coffee, Soft drinks to Surfers or competitors
- 2. Handing out Bottled Water with CS Stickers
- 3. Serving fresh homemade cakes or other home made food (Good way to connect with the ladies of the Church )
- 4. Contest crew Help setting up the contest site
- 5. Train CS Surfers up as Judges, beach marshalls and tabulators, then offer to assist at the competitions
- 6. Surf packers Hostels run by CS (Home away from Home)
- 7. Safe Houses Alcohol and drugs free houses, offered up to competitors on the Tour
- 8. Accommodation CS homes offered to travelling surfers (Ideally take some form of reference before this happens), also set guidelines for how long people can stay.
- 9. Get involved in your local surf club. Be an above normal member in helping out, but also you can serve on the committee!
- 10. Offer Prayer in general Get to know people first, but do not assume you will always get turned down.
- 11. Offer to support Christian professionals on tour, by prayer and hospitality
- 12. 'Social action' activities i.e. Litter clearance, food runs, or kids clubs. Very dependant on the requirements of your particular beach needs.
- 13. Run a surf school, with those able to pay, supplementing those who cannot.
- 14. Surfers 'Open House' Hostel Like Guaraja Surf House, Costa Rica Jaco base, or Elevate Youth Centre Bali
- 15. Get a job in the surf shop, great way of meeting all the local surfers
- 16. Combine a surf contest with a Skate contest
- 17. Befriend a visiting surfer, a local invitation to a home has huge impact
- 18. Disaster relief Be careful, but if there is help required i.e. Tsunami, Landslip etc etc, be prepared to think about how a local CS base can help
- 19. Food based Bible Studies
- 20. Beach food BBQ, pancakes etc. free to local passing surfers
- 21. Video and photography ministry Everyone loves their picture being taken, few are prepared to offer it Unless they charge a large amount of money.
- 22. Free Bands at the beach, during or at the end of the day.
- 23. Lifeguarding Courses
- 24. Board or other surf hardware donation to the poor
- 25. Focus on being the best person to surf with in the water, not the best surfer in the water
